Gwyn Jones Memorial 20/20 Navigational Rally - Friday 1st December 2017 Supplementary Regulations

ANNOUNCEMENT

Farnborough District Motor Club Ltd will organise a 20/20 Navigational Car Rally, starting at the British Car Auction site at Blackbushe Airport MR 186/794587 and finishing at Fleet Services Southbound on the M3.

JURISDICTION

1. The event will be run under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA); these Supplementary Regulations and any further written instructions that the organising clubs may issue for the event.

PERMITS

2. MSA Permit has been applied for and will be displayed at the start.

ELIGIBILITY

3. The event is open to fully elected members of Farnborough District Motor Club, Dolphin MC, Basingstoke MC, Guildford MC, Southsea MC, Oxford MC, HRCR, BAMA and Census MC
4. All competitors in the event **must** produce a valid Club Membership card at 'Signing-On'. Any competitor failing to do so **WILL NOT START THE EVENT**.

PROGRAMME

5. The programme of the meeting will be:
 - A. Signing on will commence at 20:00 and will close at 20:45.
 - B. Crew briefing will be at 20:45.
 - C. Start: Cars will start at one minute intervals in numerical order. Car 1 will start at 21:01.
 - D. Finish: Car 1 should finish about 00:30 on Saturday morning.
 - E. Results: Provisional results will be published ASAP after the last car has finished. These will be declared final after 30 minutes. In the event of a tie the organisers will use their discretion to decide the winner by furthest clean, engine size and earliest paid entry.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

6. Cars may be scrutineered to ensure roadworthiness. The carrying of an emergency triangle and first aid kit is strongly recommended.

CLASSIFICATION

7. The event will consist of 3 classes as follows:-
Experts – any crew whose navigator has won a 12 car rally or higher status road rally.
Novices – any crew not eligible as an Expert or Beginner.
Beginners – any crew whose navigator has competed in no more than 3 previous 12 cars, and has not finished in the top 3 thereof. Beginners are unfortunately not eligible to win the main event but can take victory in a separate class which carry their own award.

ENTRIES

8. The Entry fee for the event is £25.00.
9. All entries must be made on the official entry form and **received by the Secretary before Saturday 25th November 2017**. Entry forms received with no payment will be accepted as provisional. Entry forms received with payment will be confirmed and guaranteed a run. An entry list will be posted on the FDMC website showing the status of all entries and will be updated from time to time. 10. The maximum entry for the meeting is 20 the minimum is 10. Should the minimum number not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the meeting.

AWARDS

11. The Gwyn Jones Memorial Trophy will be presented to the overall winning driver and navigator at the finish. Subject to sufficient entries awards for 2nd & 3rd place will be made.

NAVIGATION

12. The event takes place on OS 1:50,000 map 186 latest edition. The route will be approx. 102 miles of finest Hampshire lanes with simple Plot and Bash navigation. A pack of sealed envelopes containing all hand-outs will be provided at signing-on. Marked maps will be available to beginners if so requested.

CONTROLS

13. There will be two types of control; Time Controls (TC) and Route Checks (RC).
Time Controls will be manned and you should ensure the marshal correctly records your time. You may wait in controls for your due time, but cannot open the navigation or leave until your due time. Controls 2, 3 & 4 will close 15 minutes after the due time of the last car. All other Controls will close 30 minutes after the due time of the last car. Maximum Permitted Lateness is therefore 30 minutes. Route Checks will take the form of code boards. You should record these on your time card in the correct place and have them signed for at the next manned control. Please ensure the information you record is legible! Example code boards will be on display at the start.

PENALTIES

14. Penalties will be imposed using the 'Time Penalty' system (R13)

A. Not reporting at a Main Time Control (MTC)	Exclusion
B. Not reporting or reporting OTL at any other Time Control (TC)	30 mins
C. Not complying with the route including visiting a control more than once	15 mins
D. Not reporting at Passage Control or providing proof of visiting Route Check	5 mins
E. Arrival before scheduled time at the end of a Standard Section	2 mins/min
F. Arrival after due time at the end of a Standard Section	1 min/min
G. Arrival before due time at the end of a Neutral Section	30 mins
K. Breach of any statutory requirement concerning use of a motor vehicle	30 mins
L. Breaking the ¾ rule (R12.7) – 1st offence - 30 mins, 2nd offence - Exclusion	
M. Excessive speed or driving likely to bring the sport into disrepute	Exclusion
N. Excessive sound	Exclusion

INSURANCE

16. Competitors must have Insurance in place which provides Third Party Liability cover that complies with the Road Traffic Act. This can be an extension to the existing motor policy for the car or purchased via the event organisers. If a competitor uses an extension to an existing policy, they will be required to sign a declaration that the cover complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act. Any responsibility for a fraudulent or misleading declaration about existing cover lies with the competitor. If a competitor wishes to purchase cover via the organisers then they can do so prior to the event providing they comply with the following.

- Age 19 years or over
- Has held a full licence for a minimum of 6 months
- Has no more than 6 points of their licence
- Has had no more than 1 fault claim in the last 3 years

Anyone aged less than 19 years old will also be accepted at the same price should their co-driver be a more senior member of their family or over 25. Any competitor, who falls outside these parameters, may be offered cover at the standard price (or a higher price) depending on circumstances. These competitors must ask the event organisers to obtain agreement from REIS prior to the event. The Event Organiser's RTA scheme is provided by REIS and underwritten by Chaucer Insurance. The standard price for the event is £15.
